

Senior lecturer position in economics: The Centre for Economic Policy Studies (EPEE) and the *Institut Universitaire de Technologie* (IUT) at the University of Evry/Paris-Saclay are inviting applications for a senior lecturer position to start on September 1, 2025.

Research areas: The research unit focuses primarily on the economic analysis of financial, environmental and socio-demographic dynamics and regulations. This activity brings together researchers who share methodologies based on theoretical modeling and econometric evaluation.

Teaching load: The teaching load is 128 hours per year, mainly in French, at the *Institut Universitaire de Technologie* (IUT).

Gross salary: The gross annual salary will be between € 28296 and € 60136 depending on the grade and the echelon of the senior lecturer.

About CEPS: The EPEE unit is part of the <u>Centre for Economics in Paris-Saclay</u> (CEPS), a research unit of the Paris-Saclay University based on two campuses, at ENS Paris-Saclay and University of Evry/Paris-Saclay. It combines research excellence with an ambitious master's and doctoral program, aimed at addressing modern economic challenges in the public debate. It is a recent department, which is developing rapidly. CEPS is an active member of the Graduate School of Economics & Management at Paris-Saclay University, bringing together departments and research units with a wide range of profiles and backgrounds.
